SELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Legal Authority/Requirement

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The AMES charter mandates that the Board of Trustee's be composed of 7 members consisting of a representative from Granite School District and Salt Lake City School District, a representative from the University of Utah undergraduate studies, the President of the PTSO, and three community members.

Board of Trustee terms may last three years depending on membership organization and bylaws of the representative organization.

Community positions will be balanced such that not all three positions will come open the same year.

If a Board position is vacated or is open by end of term, the position must be posted/advertised on the AMES web site 3 months prior to the end of the Board members term, or by the last Board meeting of the current academic year. The current Board of Trustee members will select applicant.

Board member participation is important, not only to conduct the necessary business of the school, but to have input from all partners associated with AMES.

Meetings are conducted every other month so attendance at Board meetings is critical. Perspective Board members need to be aware of the time commitment and can pledge to attend 75% of all Board meetings.

A Board member Handbook will be provided to each Board member upon confirmation by the full Board of Trustee's.
