**Job Description:** The school social worker at AMES works with individual students who are referred by counselors, teachers, or parents. They work with families to provide services either in school or at home. The social worker sits on a crisis response team that advises school administration on crisis response protocols and discusses individual student needs.

- Meet with families to identify needs that support learning.

- Follow up with students who struggle with addiction and provide resources/tools to help students and families.
- Help parents and teachers with behavior management strategies, plans, and follow-up.
- Provide check-ins for students, parents, families that are working on social, emotional, or behavioral issues.
- Sit on and advise school crisis team.
